Non-Use of “Conflict Minerals”

To Whom It May Concern:

This is to certify that Tompkins Metal Finishing, of Batavia, NY, does not knowingly source or use any “conflict minerals”, as defined in Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, as well as California Senate Bill 861, from the Democratic Republic of the Congo or any adjoining countries (“DRC Countries”) for use in chemical processing or any other manufacturing or products provided or supplies to your firm.

“Conflict minerals” include: 1) columbite-tantalite, also known as coltan (the metal ore from which tantalum is extracted); 2) cassiterite (the metal ore from which tin is extracted); 3) gold; 4) wolframite (the metal ore from which tungsten is extracted); 5) their derivatives; or 6) any other mineral or its derivatives determined by the Secretary of State to be financing conflict in the DRC Countries.

Tompkins has requested and received certifications from our suppliers that the related chemicals supplied to us and used in processing your parts are indeed “conflict free” in this regard in as much as they can establish. Copies of those supplier certificates are on-file and can be available to you upon request should it become necessary.
